EFC-MAYM MISSIONS SCHOLARSHIP Policies and Guidelines

The deadline for this scholarship application, as well as the transcript and reference letters is; for spring semester scholarships: October 1 (you will be notified by November 15); and for fall semester scholarships: **June 1** (you will be notified by July 15).

EFC-MAYM is pleased to offer scholarships to missions students at this time. The Scholarship fund first began for Spring 2005 semester and is supervised and granted by the EFC-MAYM Missions Board. The Board's desire is to give affirmation and support to Friends students who are responding to a "call" to missions, and who intend to serve in the context of the Friends Church.

The amounts of scholarship rewards is dictated by the amount of funds in the Missions Scholarship Fund – so if you are, or know of, a willing donor who wishes to support these students and Friends Missions development, funds can be sent to EFC-MAYM, 2018 Maple, Wichita, KS 67213 (designated "Missions Scholarships"). 1. Applicant shall be a member in good standing of a Friends Church and shall be in harmony with the Faith and Practice of the Yearly Meeting.
2. Applicant must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and must be preparing for full time Missions work within the Friends Church.
3. Enrollment is not limited to specific institutions, however Barclay College and others with an evangelical orientation will be given priority when reviewing applications for scholarships.
4. Enrollment shall be for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. (Please include an explanation if the enrollment will be for less).
5. A new application is required each year. It is preferable that this be typewritten. An incomplete application will not be considered.
6. The previous semester's grade point average shall be not less than 2.0. (Please provide a transcript).
7. A maximum assistance of \$500 per semester shall be granted to an applicant but final determination will be based on funds available and the number of eligible applicants.
8. Recipients of scholarship assistance shall reapply by June 1 for the next school year. Continuation of the scholarship shall be determined by need and by funds available. Each applicant will be notified by July 15 of the awards. Prior award recipients must also reapply by June 1 for the next school year. Continuation of the scholarship shall be determined by need and by funds available.
9. The maximum anyone can receive under this scholarship program is \$4,000 or 8 semesters, whichever occurs first.
10. The scholarship is a grant conditioned on the recipient's return to serve in the Friends Church. Otherwise, it becomes a loan to be repaid in accordance with the following payback schedule:
 - a. If the student returns directly from graduation to begin serving in the Friends Church:
 - i. Each 12 month period of service offsets \$1000 of tuition assistance.
 - ii. No interest shall be charged so long as the student continues in school or continues in Friends ministry.
 - b. If the person leaves the Friends ministry, either to minister elsewhere or out of ministry altogether:

- i. Uncredited balance becomes payable with the term negotiable.
 - ii. Interest shall commence, effective the date of termination from Friends service, at 1% above prime rate then being charged by Union National Bank, Wichita.
 - c. If the student goes into ministry elsewhere, or does not enter Friends Ministry:
 - i. Total balance becomes payable with the term negotiable.
 - ii. Interest shall commence, effective the concluding date of the last semester completed, at 1% above prime rate then being charged by Union National Bank, Wichita.
 - d. If the person later returns to serve a Friends church:
 - i. Unpaid loan balance, including interest, which must be current in accordance with agreement established in C above, shall then be offset as defined in A above.
 - ii. Interest shall cease on the date that Friends service commences.
 - e. If the person later leaves Friends ministry before the grant is fully credited, procedures of B shall apply
